



## Makerspace Terms of Use

I will only use Makerspace equipment after completing an induction and agreeing to the Makerspace Terms of Use.

I will respect the Makerspace, other makers, equipment and library staff.

I understand that only people who have completed an induction can use the Makerspace equipment.

I am responsible for supervising and keeping safe any minors that I bring into the Makerspace.

I am responsible for always using equipment correctly to ensure my own safety and the safety of others in the space.

I will not bring any 3D printing or laser cutting equipment or materials into the Makerspace unless I have written permission from designated Library Makerspace staff.

I alone am responsible for anything I make in the Makerspace and will not use the Makerspace equipment to create anything inappropriate, dangerous or illegal.

I will not use the Makerspace for commercial production and will minimise my consumption of materials.

I must have copyright permissions for any images or text I use to create projects in the space and will not infringe on the intellectual property of others. Moonee Valley City Council (therefore Libraries) are not responsible for intellectual property protection.

I will immediately inform library staff of any equipment malfunction, potential safety risks, damage or injury in the Makerspace.

I will follow the Moonee Valley Libraries [Membership conditions and library rules](#) while in the Makerspace.

I understand that failing to follow the Makerspace Terms of Use can mean that my 'maker status' may be revoked.

I agree that Makerspace access and use is entirely at my own risk and will not make any claims against Moonee Valley City Council or its staff to recover any loss, damage or injury that occurs in the Makerspace, or by using anything I have created using Makerspace equipment.

I understand that Moonee Valley Libraries is not responsible for any damage, personal loss or injury in the Makerspace.
